Sub: Instruction for inclusion of eligible Scheduled Tribe families etc in the BPL list

Ref: SPRD-62(18)-09/RD/SGSY/20M-6/08 Dated 14th January,2009

Sir/Madam,

I like to draw your kind attention to the letter quoted above, particularly, para (c) of the said communication. It was stated that eligible tribal families and the households, which had been completely excluded from the survey, should immediately be included in the database pending complete revision of the BPL list.

As full rectification of the BPL list requires determination of net zero increase in percentage of BPL families in a particular Block, the exercise is likely to be time consuming. So it has been decided that following categories of families viz **(1) Scheduled Tribe families, (2) Women headed households (3) Shelter less families** who have been found to be eligible for inclusion in the BPL list i.e. they have a total score less than or equal to 33 on enquiry against the claims and objections filed (by or on behalf of such families) will be considered for inclusion in the BPL list on a priority basis. The stipulation regarding net zero increase in percentage of BPL families in a particular block may be relaxed for these categories of families, if necessary. Similarly, **families which have been identified as destitute in the SAHAY survey** i.e. families eligible to be covered under SAHAY as stated in the guideline, but has not been included in the BPL list will also be considered for inclusion on a priority basis, if found eligible.

You are requested to please ensure completion of entries related to those categories of households (new entries as well as modifications) and submit us the database pertaining to the entire Block to this end for subsequent processing. Back-up of the database after completion of the entries may be e-mailed to rhsprd@gmail.com with a copy to Shri S.Chakrabarti, Programme Officer (IT) of this department (subhrachk@gmail.com) with a forwarding letter mentioning that entries related to **all claims and objections/ claims and objections pertaining to the above families** have been completed in the Block. After receiving the details as mentioned, communication will be sent, after scrutinizing the data, to the district confirming inclusion of these families in the current BPL list.
