Sub : Publication of the list of Rural Household Survey (Guideline-II).

Ref : 076/JS(DG)/2007/SGSY/20M-6/2005 dated 02.4.2007.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to our letter under reference I would request you kindly to take following actions for operationalizing of the list of Rural Household Survey which will be treated for targeting of benefits to BPL families ;

- 1) The BPL list to be derived from Rural Household Survey. This BPL list will be made operative from 1st April, 2007. All poverty alleviation programme benefits meant for persons below poverty line will be identified from among the households qualifying as BPL in this list. Except for the programme detailed in Para -3, below .
- 2) In Para-6 of the letter under reference we had requested you to generate the wait list of beneficiaries under IAY from the predefined query in the software. This list will be published as prescribed in the guideline issued by this Department from time to time. Any other lists which may have been prepared at Gram Sansad level for extending this benefits during the current year will have to be revised accordingly. A separate guideline regarding the modalities of prioritization from the wait list is being issued separately.
- 3) In respect of National Family Benefit Scheme the beneficiaries already identified before publication of this list and is pending for disposal at the level of BDO/SDO and the new cases to be received for whom the death took place on or before 31.3.2007 will , however, receive benefits they are entitled to, if found eligible. However, for deaths occurring from 1st April, 2007 onwards, the beneficiaries for NFBS will have to be selected from those featuring in the new BPL list generated from the Rural Household Survey data.
